

Greek Vocabulary Worksheet 41

Below, identify these Greek words from *Wisdom Booklet 41*. Then draw a line from each bird to its acorn.

These two “seeds” do not have birds to claim them: ἔνδυμα—clothing, μᾶλλον—much, more

The diagram shows ten birds in flight, each with a red line connecting it to an acorn. The connections are as follows:

- Bird (1) to separate connects to Acorn (2) πετεινόν
- Bird (2) bird connects to Acorn (3) τρέφω
- Bird (3) to feed connects to Acorn (9) τροφή
- Bird (4) to sow connects to Acorn (4) σπείρω
- Bird (5) to reap connects to Acorn (5) θερίζω
- Bird (6) to drink connects to Acorn (10) ψυχή
- Bird (7) through connects to Acorn (7) διά
- Bird (8) to eat connects to Acorn (8) ἐσθίω
- Bird (9) food connects to Acorn (1) διαφέρω
- Bird (10) soul connects to Acorn (6) πίνω

Two acorns are not connected to any bird: ἔνδυμα and μᾶλλον.
